

YEAR 9 ASPIRE PROGRAMME — Urban Day 1:Amazing Race in Perth.

Dates: Friday, 12 May 2023

Dear Year 9 Parents and Guardians,

On the 12 of May 2023 we putting our Geography skills into action and completing an Amazing Race in Perth city. Students will work together in small groups to visit a range of key sites and buildings and answer questions at each location in their geography booklets. The excursion will test students' practical Geography skills such as their ability to read maps, plan how to get to places, follow instructions and use public transport. Students must wear **FULL PE uniform** (no mixing full school uniform and PE uniform).

To ensure student safety throughout the excursions, students **MUST stay together** in their groups **AND regularly communicate with the teachers** with their mobile phones (talk, text, and/or Instagram). Although 'out of sight', teachers will be near students throughout the day and will be able to reach students within minutes in Perth city. If your child does not have a phone, that is okay, they will be placed in a group that has at least two phones.

#### Aims of Urban Excursion:

Academic - *To develop mapping, planning and teamwork skills.*Social/Emotional - *opportunity to build positive memories and stronger relationships with each other, and to continue to develop resilience and confidence.*Physical - *opportunity to enjoy learning outdoors together.*

Costs: students will need to bring their own lunch. Transport to the train station will be provided by the school. Students will need to bring their Smart Rider (topped up) or \$4.40 if they don't have a SmartRider. We have asked students to bring their Smart Rider into school if they want us to top it up for them.

### **Transport Information:**

As it is our first Urban Excursion, students need to come to school as normal. At 8:45am, we will travel together to the city on our school bus and then catch the train. The teachers will be with the students on the train to show them how to use public transport. This will be a key learning experience for the following excursions where students will be expected to catch public transport to and from home.

### Checklist of what to bring on Friday:

- SmartRider (for public transport concession fare) or \$4.40 if it has not been ordered. (There is no student discount without a Smart Rider)
- Lunch and Snacks. Alternatively, students can purchase their lunch
- Fully charged phone (if you have one)
- Pen
- Camera (optional)
- PE bag to carry any items if needed (must bring a school issued bag if you bring one).

Because of the special nature of these excursions, each student and parent must **submit a signed agreement** (see last page) **by Monday morning, the 8**<sup>th</sup> **of May**.
